Our Community

- To support the establishment and work of local community advisory panels
- £5k/MW of installed capacity as a baseline for new onshore wind sites
 - Shared ownership with 1% free equity
- £500 per MW of installed capacity annually for solar projects as community benefit
- Every storage project to have a community benefit fund
- Deliver at least ten £500 OnPath education bursaries for every project
- Collaborate with schools, colleges and community groups to promote STEM education and renewable energy

Our Supply Chain

- Give priority to placing local businesses on tender lists
- Make local benefits & employment a material consideration for contracting
- Require tenders for work to include a statement of local economic benefits
- Obligate companies in our local supply chain to commit to delivering direct employment
- Target a local economic benefit of £1 million/MW for all onshore wind projects
 - Ensure real living wage is paid for everyone working on our projects
